The LaSalle Rowing Club (LRC) is a volunteer-driven, not-for-profit organization located on the Detroit River in LaSalle, Ontario. Our mission is to foster a love of rowing in our members and our community. From April to October, we offer competitive, recreational and introductory on-the-water rowing for adults and youth aged 12-18 yrs old. LRC is committed to providing safe, inclusive and skill building recreational opportunities while supporting youth employment and development through structured coaching and mentorship.

Rowing Coach (up to 3 Positions)

This position provides meaningful summer employment for youth and young adults, supporting the introduction and development programs for the LRC members. The Rowing Coach will work directly with youth and adult participants, in a supportive, inclusive and safety-focused environment.

Coaches will receive training, supervision and ongoing guidance from senior board members.

Time Commitment and Compensation:

- Up to 35 hours per week
- 8-week contract beginning June 1st, 2026
- \$20.00 per hour
- Flexibility may be available to accommodate Coaches with their own training schedule.

Responsibilities:

- Plan, implement and operate Junior Summer Camp.
- Coach Intro to Row, Junior, and Adult Development rowing programs
- Support the enforcement of LRC safety standards, policies and procedures.
- Foster an inclusive, respectful and welcoming environment for all participants.
- Communicate effectively with athletes, parents/guardians and club leadership
- Assist with general club operations, including clean up and equipment maintenance.
- Model leadership, teamwork and positive sportsmanship at all times

Requirements:

- Aged 15 and 30 years old on the start date of employment
- Canadian citizen, a permanent resident of Canada, or a person who has been granted refugee status in Canada
- Valid Social Insurance Number
- Reliable transportation
- Rowing experience as an athlete and/or coach
- Valid Pleasure Craft Operator Card
- Current First Aid/CPR/AED certification prior to start date
- Minimum RCA Learn to Row Coach training prior to start date
- Strong communication and organizational skills
- Previous coaching experience considered an asset.
