#### 5. COVID-19 update

Open discussion on several topics:

Update from Smith on current status and projections / preparing to return to sport:

- Currently, there are more positive projections for Ontario: state of emergency may not extend past May 12<sup>th</sup>, which could mean slowly reopening the province. The reversal of the state of emergency, and when we can safely return to rowing needs to be closely monitored and evaluated.
- Sport Medical Advisory Committee (Chief Medical Officers of CSIO) is creating a return to sport
  protocol for national sports teams. Provincial Rowing Associations are working to take this protocol,
  add rowing-specific parameters (as well as provincial-specific guidelines), to create a plan on how to
  safely re-open rowing clubs.

**Action Item**: Continue to monitor development/impact of COVID-19, the state of emergency and provincial regulations, to determine the timeline for return to rowing. Row Ontario to use bi-weekly townhalls to share progress on how best to prepare and execute a return to rowing.

Action Item: Continue to host Row Ontario bi-weekly townhalls with members.

Row Ontario Financial picture

- Row Ontario has received most club membership forms, fees are expected to come with delay
- Row Ontario budget has been reassessed to reflect evolving COVID-19 impacts on rowing activities

**Action Item**: Continue to revisit Row Ontario budget, given ongoing COVID-19 developments and impacts.
