We're looking for a Head Coach with RCA Certification or in training status and a minimum of 5 years coaching experience.

We want someone with:

- Ability to quickly develop successful working relationships with people from different backgrounds and with varying levels of ability;
- Motivational skills and an understanding of the psychology that underpins successful competition;
- Exceptional organizational skills;
- Enthusiasm, flexibility and patience with a strong desire to help other people succeed.

The main duties of the position include:

- To lead in the development and maintenance of programs capable of providing direction, support and clear transition pathways to athletes at each stage of their growth.
- To both develop and recruit ambitious local, regional and provincial athletes to the PRC and Trent who strive to excel.
- To provide on-water expertise and build and maintain a cohesive, knowledgeable coaching staff, while advocating continuous learning, development and a commitment to the athletes of the Club/University.
- To establish and maintain a direct connection with ROWONTARIO and its Talent Development Coach and the newly appointed Trent U/PRC NextGen HUB coach, to ensure connectivity with their provincial and national development programs and teams, while maintaining an effective working relationship with other clubs and the larger provincial/national rowing community.
- To work together with the PRC Board of Directors and staff, Trent University staff, Club volunteers and members to maintain a safe, inclusive and positive atmosphere at the Club for all.

As a fulltime employee of the Peterborough Rowing Club, you will serve the year round role of Head Coach of the PRC and Head Coach of Trent Rowing. Remuneration provided will be in the range of \$38,000 and include a health benefit package.
